- Candidates must get at least 40% in each exam (with the exception of Hindi, where 33% is needed) and a minimum of 45% overall across all papers in order to be eligible for the HPJS Main Examination.
- Each paper has a set number of marks.

- Candidates who pass the main exam are eligible to take the Personality Examination, where they will receive a 150-point marks.
- To make the final selection, the results of the personality test are added to the results of the main exam.

#### **Himachal Pradesh syllabus 2025: Preliminary Examination**

- Three sections make up the Himachal Pradesh Prelims Judiciary Exam: Criminal Law, Civil Law II, and Civil Law I.
- Every part receives a score of 100, with no deductions allowed.
- For every section, there is one hour allocated.

### **Himachal Pradesh syllabus 2025: Mains Examination**

- The judiciary portion of the Himachal Pradesh Mains exam is entirely subjective.
- There are two papers focused on language proficiency and three papers on legal topics in total.
- Every paper takes three hours to complete in total.
- Candidates must receive at least 40% in each paper, with the exception of the Hindi Language Paper, which requires 33%, in order to be eligible for the interview rounds.

- In order to advance through the interview stages, candidates must score at least 45% of the 150 possible marks.
- During the viva voce rounds, candidates are judged on their disposition, legal topic knowledge, communication abilities, and ability to apply legal concepts in real-world situations.
- Candidates need to practice questions centered around legal knowledge, case analysis, current legal concerns, illustrations, and the essentials of the Indian Constitution if they want to do well in this round.
